Camp Summit

Camp Summit is an overnight Catholic adventure camp for middle school youth entering grades 6-8 hosted at Eagle Bluff in Lanesboro, Minnesota. High schoolers who have experienced the formative training of Dream Team then serve as Fiat who mentor and walk with the campers. Camp Summit is seeking dedicated, passionate and faith-filled volunteers to help create a fun and formative camp experience for Parish groups throughout the Diocese of Winona-Rochester.

Role Overview

The Adult Lead functions as a point person for all group leaders, chaperones, and volunteers at Camp Summit. They will lead daily chaperone meetings to communicate needs, run through the schedule, answer questions, pray with the chaperones, and facilitate discussion. Make sure volunteers are being supported, welcomed, given clear direction during camp. Oversees Volunteer Lead, and Nurse Lead.

Desired Characteristics & Skills

- Personable and approachable
- Strong communication skills and ability to lead a meeting
- Knowledge of Camp Summit schedule and events

Responsibilities & Duties

- Lead daily chaperone meetings during camp
- Communicate with and support group leaders throughout the entirety of camp
- Be familiar with the schedule and Camp Summit events
- Pray with and for all chaperones
- Facilitate discussion among chaperones and elicit feedback
- Help coordinate stewardship for volunteers (e.g. write and mail thank you cards)
- Connect with the Admin Lead and other lead volunteers (nurse, maintenance, etc.)
- Welcome volunteers and make sure they are set and given clear direction
- Provide resources/supplies for adults (e.g. charge and pass out walkie-talkies)

Time Commitment:

- Attend large group meetings (about 4/year)
- Available for the entirety of one week of Camp Summit
- May need to attend one training weekend based on role
- All adults 18+ must be VIRTUS trained and have a current background check within the last 5 years before any interactions with youth or Camp Summit begins
- Must fill out the online registration form online by June 1st

Expectations:

- Complete assigned tasks as needed before and during camp to ensure a fun, smooth, and successful camp experience for everyone
- Pray for Camp Summit and the youth, high schoolers, and adults experiencing God's love
- Be fully present at Camp Summit. Come prepared to work hard, play hard and pray hard. Fulfill your role with enthusiasm, love, and faith!
