Camp Summit

Camp Summit is an overnight Catholic adventure camp for middle school youth entering grades 6-8 hosted at Eagle Bluff in Lanesboro, Minnesota. High schoolers who have experienced the formative training of Dream Team then serve as Fiat who mentor and walk with the campers. Camp Summit is seeking dedicated, passionate and faith-filled volunteers to help create a fun and formative camp experience for Parish groups throughout the Diocese of Winona-Rochester.

Role Overview

Lead Nurse will use their nursing or first-aid experience to lead a group of 3-5 volunteer camp nurses during Camp Summit. The nursing team ensures the safety and care of all the middle school youth, high school youth, and adult volunteers at camp. The nursing team will provide general first aid, help youth through illness, injuries, homesickness, and helps chaperones with medications and medical emergencies.

Desired Characteristics & Skills

- Experience with nursing, EMT, CPR, and/or first aid preferred
- Leader, able to guide and delegate tasks to volunteer nurses before and during camp
- Patient and responsive to the physical and mental needs of middle and high school youth

Responsibilities & Duties

- Before camp, helps recruit more nurses for camp as needed (4-6/week)
- Creates training materials and guides for volunteer camp nurses as needed
- Reviews all camper medical forms for red flags, medication info, behavioral info and helps create action plans with parents, chaperones, Eagle Bluff staff, other nurses and leaders
- At camp, welcomes all the nurses and leads an initial meeting/orientation for all camp nurses to be on the same page about the week.
- Coordinate, organize, and staff the first aid room in the dorm building
- Assist chaperones with medications, questions, and incidents
- Responsive during medical emergencies (e.g. Contact parents, escort person to the hospital, coordinate with other nurses and chaperones)
- Checks in with all volunteer nurses throughout the week. Ensure nurses are being supported, given clear direction, and have the supplies they need.

Time Commitment:

- Attend large group meetings (2-3/year)
- Available for the entirety of one week of Camp Summit
- All adults 18+ must be VIRTUS trained and have a current background check within the last 5 years before any interactions with youth or Camp Summit begins
- Must fill out the online registration form online by June 1st

Expectations:

- Complete assigned tasks as needed before and during camp to ensure a fun, smooth, and successful camp experience for everyone
- Pray for Camp Summit and the youth, high schoolers, and adults experiencing God's love.
- Be fully present at Camp Summit. Come prepared to work hard, play hard and pray hard. Fulfill your role with enthusiasm, love, and faith!
